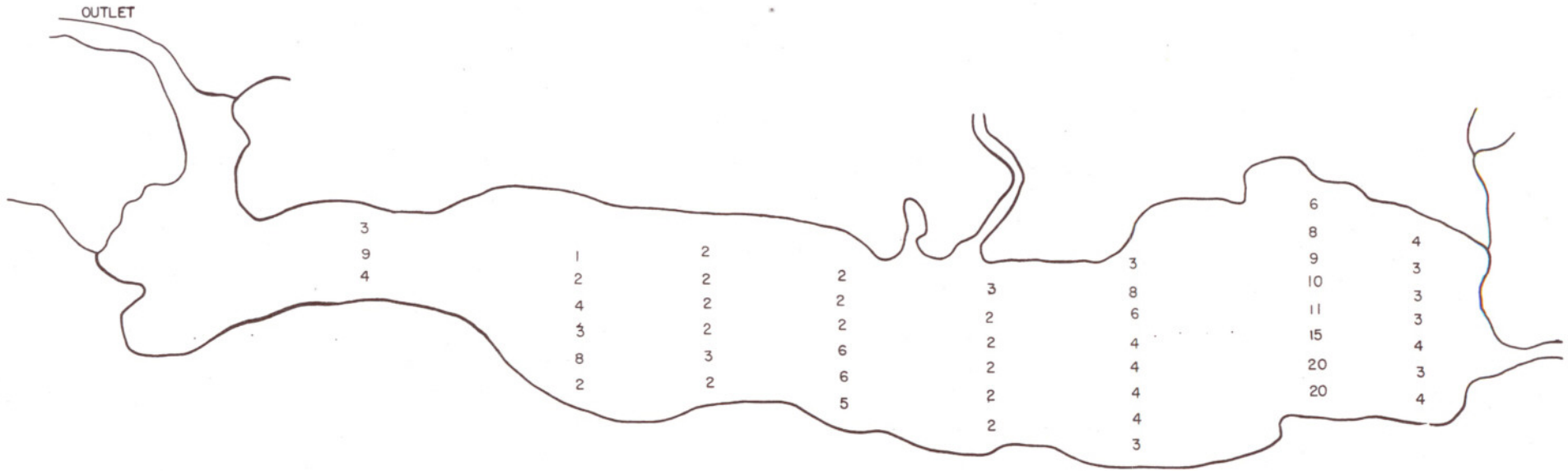
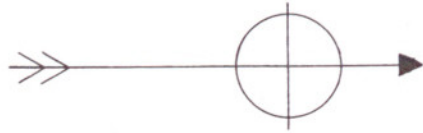

Suggested Management

Most of the area of this lake is extremely shallow and weedy, and provides excellent habitat for pickerel. The small area of moderate depth is inhabited by white perch, smallmouth bass, and yellow perch. There is too much competition for a brook trout population.

Wangan Brook is suitable for, and supports, a population of brook trout. This brook has sufficient spawning and nursery areas to produce the number of trout that it can support. A few trout migrate down to the lake and are occasionally taken.

The white and yellow perch should be more heavily fished to better utilize the fishery.
