*North Windham Moves: Regional Mobility - Local Access Project*

The Project location file is included in the application. The Project is designated *urban* but is truly a blend of urban- and rural-related components and needs. The entire Project is located within **Census Tract 48.01**. It is within the Portland, Maine Urbanized Area 71263.<sup>1</sup> *2010 Census Tract Reference Map: Maine 23, Cumberland: 005, North Windham 53685, Windham town 86025*<sup>2</sup>

The Portland, Maine UA has a population of 203,914, further designating the Project *urban*.<sup>3</sup> *(Under the Census Bureau's new definition of urban, North Windham remains urban with a population of 10,271 and 5,183 housing units as well as land area of 14.0 square miles.)*<sup>4</sup>
