Heading South

If heading South on interstate 95, take Exit 112 for ME-8/ME-11/ME-27 toward **Augusta/Belgrade** to the right. Follow ME-27 approximately 1 mile. The Elks Lodge is on the right just past the traffic light.

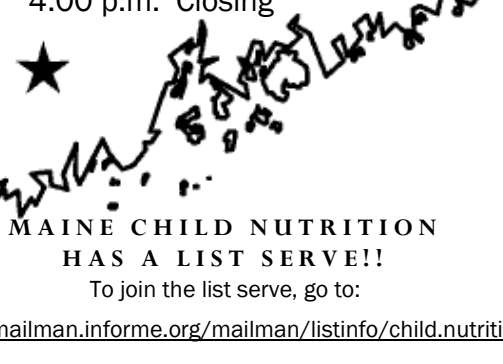
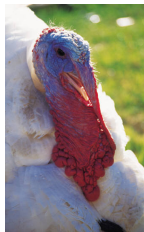
