Suggested Management

Second Little Lyford Pond is not connected directly to First Little Lyford. Both ponds flow into the West Branch of the Pleasant River.


This small shallow pond should be managed for the brook trout fishery presently enjoyed there.

The use of live fish as bait should be prohibited to prevent introductions of competing species. Ice fishing should not be allowed because the pond is so small and shallow.

The small inlet is providing facilities for natural reproduction and should be kept clear at all times. The small water control dam at the outlet should either be removed or made into a two step fishway to allow free migration to and from the pond.
