

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THE MAINE MOOSE LOTTERY IF:

- You did not obtain a permit in 2007 or 2008 by lottery drawing.
- You are eligible to obtain a Maine Big Game Hunting License, or will be eligible to obtain a Maine Big Game Hunting License by the

opening day of the moose hunting season.

- **NOTE:** Although a junior hunting license can be pre-issued before the holder is 10 years old, be advised that the license and permit cannot be used until the youngster is 10 years old.

Application Instructions: Fill out all information. Any application that is not filled out completely, legibly, and accurately will be disqualified.

No person may file more than one application. Any person submitting more than one application will be disqualified.

- 1 Enter your name, mailing address, legal residence, and date of birth. Indicate whether or not you applied last year.
- 2 **Residents:** Check one box indicating the number of chances you wish to purchase. To purchase 3 or 6 chances, you must provide a valid 2009 big game hunting license number. **Note:** Superpack license holders are entitled to 6 chances at no fee. If you are a Superpack license holder, please check the box for 6 chances, check the box indicating you are a Superpack license holder, and fill-in your Superpack license number. In this case you do not need to include payment with your application. **Nonresidents:** Check one box indicating the number of chances you wish to purchase. **Note:** You may purchase as many multiples of 10 chances at \$55 each as you would like. Please indicate the number of multiples that you would like to purchase and the total cost. For example, 5 multiples of 10 chances would cost \$275 (5 x \$55 = \$275).
- 3 Indicate the season(s) you wish to hunt by checking the appropriate box.
- 4 Indicate whether or not you would accept an antlerless-only permit if that is the only permit available at the time you are drawn. If the hunts you have indicated you would accept are not available when you are drawn, you will not receive a permit and you will keep your bonus points.
- 5 Enter up to 10 WMDs in order of preference. Put first WMD choice in "1st choice" box, etc. If you do not indicate any WMD preferences, your application will be returned. If you indicate at least one WMD preference, but at the time of the drawing your preferred districts are filled, you will be placed in a WMD as close as possible to your first choice, unless you check the box to indicate that you only want the WMDs that you selected.
- 6 Enter subpermittee information (see back of application for further information).
- 7 Sign and date your application. Please include a daytime phone number (this will only be used to contact you if we need additional information to complete your application.)
- 8 Provide payment in U.S. funds by credit card, or check/money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of Maine". **Do not send cash.** A fee of \$20 is charged for each insufficient funds check.

INSTRUCTIONS *cont'd*

Applications must be postmarked by May 1, 2009, or delivered in person to 284 State Street, Augusta, Maine no later than 5 p.m. on May 1, 2009, or submitted via the internet at www.mefishwildlife.com no later than 11:59 p.m. May 15, 2009.

Note: If mailing very close to the deadline, please ensure application is date stamped by the post office to ensure postmark is prior to deadline.

Permittees will be selected by a computerized random drawing on June 18, 2009.

- Each successful applicant in the permit drawing will be notified by mail shortly after the drawing. It is very important that you provide a mailing address where you can be reached at this time.
- The notification letter will indicate a deadline for responding with the appropriate permit fee and hunting license number. **Permit fees are \$52.00 for residents or \$477.00 for nonresidents.**
- Applicants not selected in the drawing will NOT be notified.
- The winners' names will be posted on our web site www.mefishwildlife.com and will be published in many newspapers the day after the drawing.

At the time of application, each applicant may select one person as the subpermittee to participate in the moose hunt. An alternate subpermittee may also be designated at this time. By law, no one other than one of these two people may be designated as the subpermittee. The permittee must be present during the hunt or the subpermittee cannot hunt. Do not list yourself in either of the subpermittee boxes.

If you do not want to hunt with a subpermittee, leave the subpermittee part of the application blank.

BONUS POINTS

The Department awards one bonus point per year to every applicant for each consecutive, unsuccessful year of entry into the drawing. Each point gives the applicant an additional chance in the drawing. To ensure you receive bonus points, we strongly recommend that you:

- Apply early;
- Make sure you apply using the same name and DOB as last year.
- Make sure you indicate on the application that you applied last year.

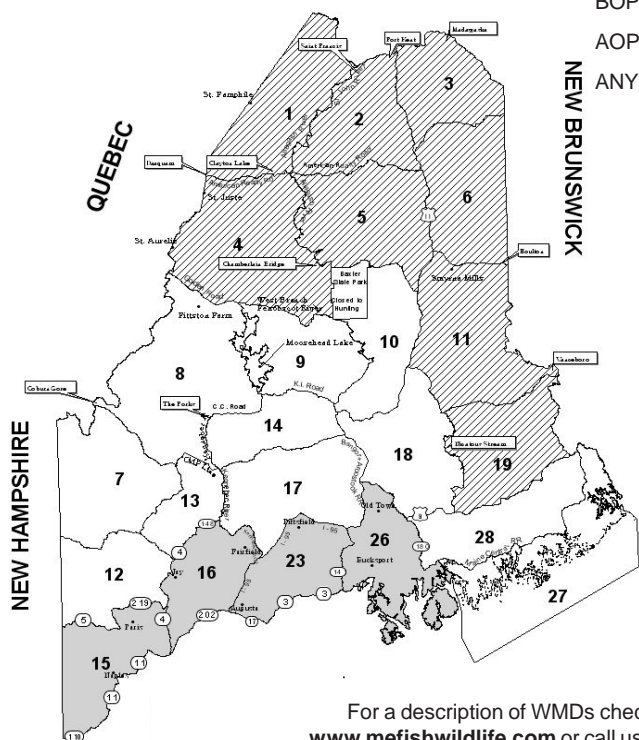
Bonus points are forfeited if:

- You skip a year in applying by failing to purchase a chance;
- You obtain a moose permit through the drawing;
- You are selected for a permit and later decline and/or fail to meet the criteria for legally possessing that permit;
- You are found to have not legally applied in the current year; or
- You enter the incorrect name or date of birth on the application or you fail to indicate that you applied last year.

BOP = Bull Only Permit

AOP = Antlerless Only Permit

ANY = Any-moose Permit
