

with the Board of January 7, 1991. Subsequent to the filing of a response by the Town of Northport, the Board scheduled this appeal for hearing which hearing was set for April 28, 1992. That hearing was continued at the request of the Petitioner who asked that the hearing be rescheduled to "late May."

Since the Board was unable to convene a quorum, the May 27, 1992 hearing was rescheduled to June 11, 1992. Reverend Nargesian requested that the June 11 hearing be continued, a request which the Board granted. A new hearing date was set for February 19, 1993.

Prior to the February 19, 1993 hearing date, the Petitioner wrote the Board's secretary requesting information to assist him in the preparation of his case in anticipation of the February 19 hearing. On February 11, 1993 the Board received a letter from Reverend Nargesian requesting another continuance.

The Board considered the Petitioner's request for a continuance. After reviewing the history of this appeal, including the numerous continuances, the Board, by a vote of 5-0, denied Petitioner's request for a continuance.


In addition, because the Petitioner failed to appear at the scheduled hearing held February 19, 1993, the Board, by unanimous vote, hereby dismissed the pending Petition for want of prosecution.

Any party wishing to appeal this Decision must file a petition for Review in the Superior Court within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A. §§1001-

11008. If this Decision is not appealed, it shall become binding on the parties at the end of said 30-day period.
