



TORONTO FUN FACTS

- 4.5 million people live in the Greater Toronto Area. (GTA)
- Toronto is the #1 visitor destination in Canada with 35,000 hotel rooms and 120 hotels
- 180 million Americans are within 90 minutes by air
- 150 million Americans live within a one-day drive of Toronto
- After New York City, Toronto has the 2nd largest public transportation system in North America
- Toronto has more print, radio, and television outlets than any other city in North America
- The University of Toronto is North America's third largest university
- Toronto is home to the largest pediatric hospital in North America
- The CN Tower is the world's tallest freestanding structure
- Yonge Street is the longest street in the world (1,896 km or 1,178 miles)
- Toronto has the second largest international film festival after Cannes and Toronto per-capita has the largest movie-going population in North America
- Toronto is the third largest live theatre centre in the English speaking world with more than 70 theatre productions every month
- In the Toronto region you will find more than 100 shopping centres including the Toronto Eaton Centre located downtown with over 300 stores under one roof.
- Toronto has 60 year-round attractions including the largest museum in Canada the ROM
- Toronto has more than 10,000 acres of parkland and there are more than 300 golf courses within an hour's drive of the city.
- Toronto is home to five professional sports teams (Maple Leafs, Raptors, Blue Jays, Argos and the Rock)
- The Rogers Centre is the only stadium in the world with a fully retractable roof and both the Roman Coliseum and St. Paul's Cathedral can fit comfortably inside the Rogers Centre stadium.
- There are at least 7,000 restaurants in Toronto and Torontonians spend nearly \$3 billion annually on food prepared outside of the home
- There are over 300 bicycle couriers in Toronto
