Board members expressed concern over MDOT's expansion of its spray program to cover guardrails and pavement cracks given the legislative mandate to minimize reliance on pesticide use. However, since MDOT has reduced its use of herbicides in recent years, the spirit of the law has been met. Also, please bear in mind that MDOT's variance permit requires agency contractors and personnel to adhere to the measures outlined in Section IX of the permit application.
