PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with 5 M.R.S.A Section 6200 et seq., the Land for Maine's Future Board announces that it will be voting on a proposal to allocate funds to support the ME Department Inland Fisheries and Wildlife of fee simple acquisition of 49.3± acres of unimproved, forested land, which encompasses the entirety of "Oscar Pond", and having approximately 1,600 feet of frontage along East Side Road. Access to the property is directly provided from East Side Road. The property is located in Addison, Washington County, State of Maine and is further described as the property of John K. Marshall and Anne E. Marshall and identified on Town of Addison Tax Map 16, portion of Lot 9. The ME Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife anticipates that this property will be used for wildlife habitat land conservation and recreational land.

Public comment on this acquisition will be accepted at the Land for Maine's Future Board meeting on January 22, 2013. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 1p.m. the Department of Agriculture, Conservation, and Forestry's Bolton Hill facility, 2870 North Belfast Ave, Augusta, Maine.
