**PETITION TO INTERVENE BY CITIZENS FOR  
CLEAN AND SECURE ENERGY, INC.**

Pursuant to Chapter 30 § 5(A)(1) of the Department of Environmental Protection regulations, Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc., hereby petitions to intervene in the above-listed proceeding. A petition shall be granted if the petition demonstrates that it: (1) has a direct and substantial interest that may be affected by the proceeding; (2) has reasonably specific contentions regarding the subject matter of the hearing and the appropriate statutory criteria; and (3) is prepared and capable of participation in the hearing to support such contentions. 06-096 Ch. 30 §5(A)(1). Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc. therefore petitions to intervene and states the following:

1. Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc. ("Citizens"), a domestic nonprofit company, is composed of citizens of the City of Calais, Washington County and Downeast Maine who have been active over the past three years in supporting the development and permitting of the proposed Calais LNG Project Company, LLC and the Calais Pipeline Project Company, LLC ("Calais LNG") project. Citizens and its members are interested in ensuring that the Calais LNG project is designed, constructed and operated in a manner that is protective of the health of the residents of Washington County and beyond, and that the project does not have unreasonable


adverse effects on the environment. Citizens is also interested in securing natural gas as a clean source of energy for the region in order to reduce dependence on dirtier fuel oil and to improve air quality. Numerous organized meetings have been held on a reoccurring basis with Calais LNG project developers, scientists and consultants to learn about project specifics, the safety record of the LNG industry, the environmental and economic benefits of the project, and how Calais LNG proposes to avoid, minimize or mitigate any potential environmental impacts associated with the project development and operation. The open dialogue between Calais LNG and the group has allowed its members to be educated on components of the project, ranging from potential natural resource impacts to potential jobs created for citizens of Downeast Maine.

2. Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc. has specific contentions relating to the Calais LNG permit applications that are subject to these proceeding, including but not limited to the following:
  - i. Citizens seeks to ensure that the Board hear the full story concerning Calais LNG's compliance with statutory and regulatory approval standards. The group believes and contends that the proposed project has been sited and designed in a manner that will not adversely affect the existing uses, scenic character, air quality, water quality, visual quality or other natural resources within the municipality.
  - ii. The group believes and contends that Calais LNG will engineer its project's construction and operation in a manner that minimizes concerns as to lighting, noise and visual impacts.

- iii. Citizens believes and contends that LNG vessel traffic will have minimal impact upon the waterway, which members of the group themselves utilize and enjoy. In addition, the group believes and contends that Calais LNG will not negatively impact the local fishery.
  - iv. The group believes and contends that natural gas is a bridge fuel that can and will supplement power generation from renewable resources, and that as a bridge fuel, it will help reduce harmful air emissions in the region and throughout the State of Maine.
3. Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc. is prepared and capable of participation in the hearing to support its contentions, including participating in all pre-hearing conferences, providing detailed and accurate prefiled testimony and participating at any public hearing required by the Board.
4. Based on the foregoing, Citizens for Clean and Secure Energy, Inc. has satisfied the requirements for intervention and respectfully requests that it be granted Intervenor status in this proceeding.
