





Don't throw away or flush medications.

Please bring your unused, unwanted or outdated personal or veterinarian medications (no needles, lancets or syringes) to one of these locations.



Medication collection is for individual households only, not for health care facilities.

- **China Transfer Station** – 191 Alder Park Road
- **Clinton Police Station** – 27 Baker Street
- **Fairfield Police Station*** – 75 Water Street
- **Oakland Police Station*** – 7 Fairfield Street
- **Waterville Police Station*** – 1 Common Street
- **Winslow Police Station*** – 114 Benton Avenue

* These police departments have secure medication drop boxes and accept medications from the public any day the lobby is open: Fairfield, Oakland, Waterville and Winslow
