





Don't throw away or flush medications.

Please bring your unused, unwanted or outdated personal or veterinarian medications (no needles, lancets or syringes) to one of these locations.



Medication collection is for individual households only, not for health care facilities.

- **Clinton Police Station** – 27 Baker Street
- **Fairfield Police Station*** – 75 Water Street
- **Madison Police Station*** – 28 Weston Avenue
- **ME State Police, Troop C** – 162 West Front Street, Skowhegan
- **Pittsfield Police Station*** – 112 Somerset Avenue
- **Somerset Sheriff's Office*** – 131 East Madison Road, Madison

* These police departments have secure medication drop boxes and accept medications from the public any day the lobby is open: Fairfield, Madison, Pittsfield and Somerset Sheriff's Office
