





Don't throw away or flush medications.

Please bring your unused, unwanted or outdated personal or veterinarian medications (no needles, lancets or syringes) to one of these locations.



Medication collection is for individual households only, not for health care facilities.

- **Gardiner Police Station** – 6 Church Street
- **Hallowell Police Station** – One Winthrop Street
- **Litchfield Transfer Station** – 2400 Hallowell Road
- **Monmouth Transfer Station** – 126 Route #135
- **Readfield/Wayne Transfer Station** – North Street, Readfield
- **West Gardiner Fire Department** – 318 Spears Corner Road
- **Windsor Historical Society** – Windsor Fairgrounds, Route 32
- **Winthrop Transfer Station** – Route 202
