



Almost half the people receiving community and facility-based long term services and supports have dementia.

Dementia Diagnosis by Setting




As the disease progresses, so does the need for greater supervision, more help with activities of daily living, and eventually help with palliative and end of life care. The proportion of people with dementia increases with each higher level of care.

Caregiver status by dementia diagnosis in the home care setting





Number of people with one or more falls in the past 30 days:




Average hours of caregiver support (per week)




Total MaineCare and Medicare Payments for MaineCare Members (SFY 2010)



MaineCare payments for people with dementia are concentrated in the nursing facility




Average Per Person Per Month Medicare and Medicaid Payments




Cognitive Performance Scale (CPS)

- CPS 6: Severe Impairment


People with Dementia
