

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROCKWEED CUTTER RAKE

1. Rake width can vary from 12 inches to 18 inches.
2. Rake can be equipped with small blades or one large “V” blade.
3. Cutting blade or blades are to be between 2 to 3 inches from the rake teeth.
4. Cutting blade or blades are to be angled parallel with the rake handle.
5. It is very important that edge of blades are not rusted and kept very sharp.
6. All cutter rakes require runners at both ends.
7. Rakes longer than 12 inches will require a runner in the center.
8. Runners are to be securely attached to the rake body, so as not to bend or become detached from the rake.
9. Runners are required to have sufficient distance between the cutting blades and the bottom of the runners to have 16 inches of plant stem length remaining and attached to the substrate.
