(RESOLVE – L.D 1534)

“Advise the ACF Committee on land use planning and regulation in the U.T.”

- Consider reforming LURC
 - Make recommendations on
 1. The role of state agencies and county government
 2. The planning and appeals process
 3. Opportunities for increased self determinations in land use planning in the U.T.
- [If the elimination of the LURC Commission is recommended
 - Make recommendations that ensure an effective transition process]
- Ensure uniform standards across the U.T. in certain areas
 - In timber harvesting and forest management
 - In wildlife habitat (management)
 - In areas related to NRPA – The Natural Resource Protection Act (e.g., wetlands, prime wildlife habitat)
- [Consider options for reforming governance of land use planning in the U.T.]

REQUIREMENTS

- Two or more public listening sessions
- The Department of Conservation will staff/fund with existing resources
- Members will receive no compensation for time, travel, other expenses
- The Commissioner of Conservation shall invite resource people to assist as appropriate, including past LURC commissioners and staff

DEADLINES

- October 28th or before: meet with legislative ACF Committee for an “update on the progress of the commission.”
- December 15th or before: The” commission will complete its work.”
- January 4, 2012 or before: The commission will “submit its report and recommendations to the ACF Committee.”
