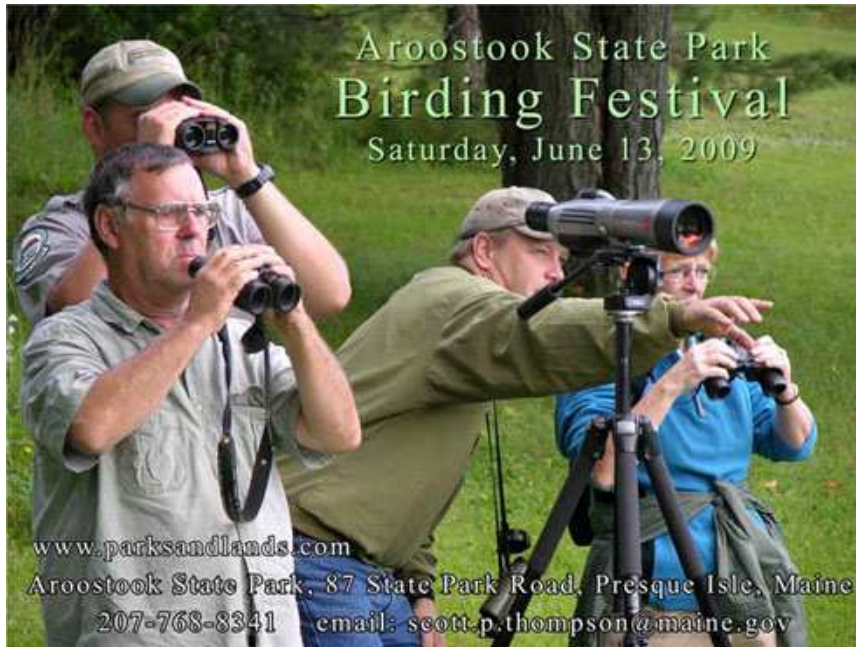


Schedule of events
