

Ad Hoc Advisory Committee for Standards Based Student Centered Education in RSU #2.

A. The purpose of the committee, the specific issue(s) for study and the scope of the committee's activity, "To assist the RSU communities and staff in successfully achieving a Standards Based Student Centered School System."

B. The composition of the committee, including designation of voting and non-voting, if applicable. "The composition of three district (H-D, R, M) committees will include teachers, parents and administrators from ES, MS and HS and a student from HS. Dresden will include 3 teachers, 3 parents and Principal. These four groups will individually focus on their community and schools and collectively meet to review the development of the goal within the RSU."

Principal will be asked to secure representatives.

C. The length of time each member is expected to serve "a two year commitment".

D. The role of the committee as being advisory only "advisory only".

E. The resources the Board will provide to assist the committee in completing its task. "The Board will provide registration and mileage to attend training, books, research articles, and samples of products and forms.

F. The expectations regarding the committee's relationship with the Board, the Superintendent, and RSU personnel. "The Committee will be advisory to the Board through the Superintendent and Administrative Team.

G. The designation of the individual who will be responsible for providing information to the public concerning the committee and its work. "The Chairperson of the committee will be the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment."

H. The time and place of the first meeting  
"With the approval of the committee structure in February the board will be presented with names of people who have become the representatives in March and a first meeting will be scheduled by the middle of the month."

I. The timeline and content of progress reports to the Board and other activities. "Quarterly progress reports will include minutes of meetings and attendance at training sessions which focus upon the first two stages of development (awareness and understanding)."

J. The date on which the Board expects to receive a final report or recommendations and dissolve the committee. "The Board will receive reports every four months through June 30, 2011 at which time the purpose of the committee will be reassessed or dissolved."
