## **Mission Statement**

The mission of the Madison Area Memorial High School community is to inspire academic and personal excellence in a safe learning environment where all students can develop the skills necessary to lead purposeful lives as responsible citizens and lifelong learners.

## **The School and Its Community**

Madison Area Memorial High School is a public four-year comprehensive high school of approximately 300 students with a teaching staff of twenty-three. Madison is a small, rural community on the Kennebec River. It is approximately 45 miles north of the state capitol, Augusta, and 40 miles southeast of Sugarloaf Mountain, USA. It has a population of approximately 5000. Paper production is a major industry with UPM Madison, located within the village, employing approximately 240 people. "UPM leads in the integration of bio and forest industries into a new, sustainable and innovation-driven future." Sappi Fine Paper is located 15 miles away. Wood harvesting and wood product manufacturing provides its primary source of employment with farming and dairy production as secondary. Madison is also home to "Backyard Farms" a 42 acres of year-round greenhouse growing space providing vine-ripened tomatoes delivered daily throughout the Northeast. Backyard Farms has plans for further development and employs approximately 200 people

## **Class Rank**

Beginning in the Spring of 2006, Madison Area Memorial High School began **weighting honors classes at 1.03; advanced placement and articulated classes through Thomas College and Kennebec Valley Community College at 1.05.** A weighted and unweighted GPA and class rank are computed at the end of each semester which includes all grades in all courses, except those classes that are pass/fail.

## **CLASS OF 2013 STATISTICS**

The Class of 2013 graduated 64 students. 56% will continue their education in four-year programs; 12% entered a two-year or community college program; and 8% entered the military.

## **HONORS, ADVANCED PLACEMENT, ONLINE**

**Honors** classes are offered in all major subject areas—English, mathematics, science and history.

**Advanced Placement** courses are for students who demonstrate high achievement in a particular subject area. These advanced placement classes include English Language, U.S. Government, and Environmental Science. Calculus, Statistics, U.S. History, Biology and Physics are offered depending on student enrollment.

**Dual Enrollment** classes are offered in English, Calculus, Accounting and Computer Applications.

## **Online Classes**

Madison Area Memorial High School offers extensive online honors and advanced placement classes through Virtual High School, the University of Maine Academ-E, and AP4ALL.
