

MAINE FFA AGRISCIENCE FAIR EVENT

To qualify for the Maine FFA Agriscience Fair students must...

- Be in grades 7 – 12.
- Conduct a scientific research project pertaining to the agriculture and food science industries and, present their findings to a panel of judges with a display and a report.
- Submit their full written report and application to the National FFA Organization postmarked by **April 17, 2014**.

Students can compete in the Maine FFA agriscience fair in one of six categories:

- Animal Systems
- Environmental Services/Natural Resource Systems
- Food Products and Processing Systems
- Plant Systems
- Power, Structural and Technical Systems
- Social Systems
