Light Online Short Course Builds Teacher Content Knowledge

For grades 3-9 teachers, NSTA's online short courses offer professional development in physical science concepts. Available directly from your computer, the short course combines asynchronous learning with live web sessions to help you master this science content.

The new course: **Light** led by Dr. Matt Bobrowsky:

- Offered from 8:00 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. (Eastern Time) beginning Tuesday, October 13, 2009 and on the following Tuesdays, 10/20, 10/27, 11/3, and 11/10.
- The instructor, NSTA staff, and the virtual classroom of students post and answer questions and share comments about the topic.
- Follow-up weekly discussions are posted on the course forum, and self-paced completion of corresponding course materials (SciPack, SciGuide, e-Book, journal article, and book chapter) all contribute to boosting knowledge of the subject.
- The NSTA member rate is a short course \$326.59 and the non-member rate is \$371.01.
- Two graduate professional development credits from the University of Idaho can be earned for an additional fee.
- If taken for credit, the participants will receive a letter grade.
