## **Alternate Assessment Alignment Work Phase 2**

The Alternate Assessment (PAAP) is conducting phase two of an alignment study to verify the alignment of the Alternate Grade Level Expectations (AGLEs) with our current Task Bank.

We are conducting this work in conjunction with our fall workshops. Each session will run from 8:00-4:00. Lunch will be provided. Substitute reimbursement for those requiring coverage in the classroom, as well as mileage reimbursement will be provided. For those traveling over 70 miles, overnight accommodations will/can also be provided.

The following are the scheduled dates for this work to be done.

Reading: October 29 (Calumet Club, Augusta, Maine)

Mathematics: November 1 (Calumet Club, Augusta, Maine)

Science: November 3 (Ramada, Saco, Maine)

We are seeking 10 individuals per content area. The groups will consist of 6 special educators (at least one from each level), 4 content area teachers (at least one from each level).

There will be a pre-alignment webinar that will take place prior to the work date to provide training for the work to be done. All participants will be paid an honorarium for this work and any required preparatory work done.
