February PAAP Update

We are two months into the PAAP Administration window. Many of you have accessed the Task Bank, set up your student lists, and are working on compiling student work.

If you have not accessed the Task Bank at this time, you will need to have an access code for your school. This is an eight digit number that is a combination of your district and school code. If you are unsure of your access code, contact either Sue Fossett (624-6774) or Peter Bernard (624-6678) for this information.

We do want to remind everyone of the importance of getting into the Task Bank early so that you have the ability to teach, assess, re-teach and reassess as needed. We will be creating our list for return materials for only those students enrolled in the Task Bank as of April 1, 2011.

If you have students on your Student List that you have since determined will not take part in PAAP, please make sure that you delete them from your list prior to April 1, 2011.

Since the Task Bank has opened, we have also added a Partial PAAP button that we ask that you check if you are submitting only a partial PAAP.

Finally, regardless of the students enrolled grade (9, 10, 11, or 12), if the student is in their 3rd year of high school, they must be assessed. Please contact Sue Fossett if you have any issues with enrolling these students. 3rd year high school students must be listed as an 11th grader in the Task Bank in order to access all the required tasks.
