PAAP Return Shipping Materials Have Been Sent to Schools

Return shipping materials for the 2010-11 PAAP were mailed to schools on Tuesday, April 12. All schools with students registered in the Task Bank will be receiving a shipping kit for each student. Included in the kits you will find two shipping envelopes, packaging instructions, and a separate document – the LCI Study survey.

One of the envelopes will bear the bar-coded student label. The other will have a UPS shipping label affixed to it. Place the portfolio in the first envelope (bearing the student label); that envelope should then be inserted into the UPS shipping envelope, which in turn should be sealed and dropped off at your school's UPS contact point (the front office, usually) before May 3.

UPS will be visiting all schools with registered PAAP students on May 3 to pick up the packages and return them to Measured Progress.

Teachers: If by Friday, April 15, you have not been notified by your front office that the materials have arrived, please follow up.
