## **Important Information Regarding the PAAP Task Bank**

Today, December 1<sup>st</sup>, is the first day of the PAAP Administration Window. We encourage you to access the PAAP Task Bank and register those students that will be participating in the 2010-2011 assessment.

We also want to make you aware of a minor glitch in the PAAP Task Bank that impacts 3<sup>rd</sup> year high school students. If you have a student who is currently in his or her 3<sup>rd</sup> year of high school but is enrolled in a grade *other* than grade 11, you **MUST** contact Sue Fossett at the Maine Department of Education, [susan.fossett@maine.gov](mailto:susan.fossett@maine.gov) or 624-6774 in order to correctly assess this student.

Only those students who are in their third year of high school are required to take part in all content areas of PAAP. If you have a student who is enrolled in Infinite Campus State Edition (ICSE) as a grade 10 student, but is in his/her 3<sup>rd</sup> year of high school, currently the Task Bank will only allow access to grade 10 tasks. This would also impact a student that is in grade 9 or 12 as a 3<sup>rd</sup> year high school student, as access to all of the appropriate tasks may not be available.
