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

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

Maine Teacher of the Year

The Maine Teacher of the Year is an outstanding teacher who best represents the thousands of excellent educators in Maine. She or he serves as an advocate for the teaching profession, education and students.

Who is eligible to be nominated?

All Maine certified K-12 teachers are eligible to be nominated, from private schools as well as public schools.

Who can nominate a teacher?

Any teacher, parent, student, or community member may nominate a teacher by contacting the building principal who then convenes a committee to complete the nomination papers.

THE PROCESS

- Nomination papers are available online in November and are due back at the Department of Education in February.
- Semi-finalists are scored through 1) a school visit; 2) an oral presentation; and 3) a professional portfolio.
- The highest scorers of those three events become the State finalists.
- State finalists are interviewed by former Maine Teachers of the Year.
- The Maine Teacher of the Year is celebrated in a surprise all-school assembly in September.
- The Maine Teacher of the Year becomes part of the National Teacher of the Year selection process.
- The Maine Teacher of the Year participates in five national events.
- The Maine Teacher of the Year can expect to be involved with a variety of programs, serve on boards and associations, and participate as guest speaker.
