

Suggested Management


Salmon Brook Lake is a typical example of a shallow lake that is gradually filling in and nearing the end of its productive life. It has little potential for supporting a sport fishery for coldwater game fish. Trout are taken in the deadwater sections of the inlet and outlet, which are considered part of the lake.
