RE: **Priorities for bills on Appropriations Table**

Pursuant to Joint Rule 314(7), we are reporting our committee's priorities for final passage of bills reported out of our committee that are now on the Appropriations Table. On the day, the committee received the list of bills to prioritize, LD 984 failed enactment (some members lists include it in their ranking and others do not).

Attached are forms signed by each committee members indicating how they voted on the priority recommendations.

Here is a summary of the priorities:

LD	1 st priority
494	3 members ranked LD 494 as their top priority; 2 ranked it second
940	4 members ranked LD 940 as their top priority; 5 ranked it second
1221	4 members ranked LD 1221 as their top priority; 1 ranked it second
1492	2 members ranked LD 1492 as their top priority; 3 ranked it second
