

Environmental Impact Statement Information

Please Note: This information is subject to change

1. The Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the modification of the Condor 1 and 2 MOA, is still in draft form awaiting the outcome of our meeting with the Penobscot Tribe on January 10, 2011.
2. After that, the Draft EIS requires a final legal review before it is releasable to the general public and pertinent agencies for 30 days.
3. Once the 30 day review period is completed and barring any significant changes/updates, the National Guard Bureau (NGB) will sign a Record of Decision (ROD) finalizing the EIS process (~ March 2011).
4. The Final EIS and ROD will then be sent to the FAA so they can conduct their own internal review of the EIS. After the internal review, the FAA intends to hold a public hearing in Maine.
