

Union Street Bridge Replacement, Phase 2

South Lanes Closing The Week Of June 1st



The Union Street Bridge project enters Phase 2 with the closing of the south lanes of the bridge and the demolition of the old bridge. Traffic patterns will remain the same, including right-turns-only when entering or exiting interstate ramps. There will be two lanes of traffic on the bridge and a sidewalk will be available on the north side. The new \$8.8 million bridge will have an additional lane to relieve congestion, higher clearance for vehicles passing beneath on I-95, and six-foot sidewalks.
