The following questions have been received:

Question: Would you please clarify note 1 of Section 105 (limitations of operations)?

Response: Restricted roadway width which will not accommodate two way traffic will be allowed only between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. Any restriction to two way traffic outside this work window will result in a traffic control violation and the appropriate penalty will be assessed according to Special Provision 652. Each fifteen interval before 9:00 am or after 4:00 pm that two way traffic is restricted will be a separate violation. The Contractor's Traffic Control Plan will specifically address how traffic will be managed during this work window including measures in place to keep traffic delays to no more than five minutes.

Question: Page 5 of 6 in section 104 (utilities) states that railroad flaggers will be required when working within the Railroad R.O.W., will the contractor be responsible for the cost of railroad flaggers?

Response: The Contractor is not responsible for payment of Railroad flaggers. The Contractor is responsible for scheduling the flaggers.
