NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Sealed Bids addressed to the Maine Department of Transportation, Augusta, Maine 04333 and endorsed on the wrapper "RFP for Burner Services, Region 2" will be received from contractors at the Reception Desk, Maine DOT Building, 24 Child Street, Augusta, Maine, until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (prevailing time) on November 18, 2009, and at that time and place publicly opened and read. All other Bids may be rejected.

Description: The Maine Department of Transportation is accepting Proposals for annual preventive maintenance and repair services as needed for oil fired burner units on patch heaters, culvert steamers, and pressure washers in the Mid-Coast Maine Region.

Location: Various locations in the counties of Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo.

Outline of Work: Provide one annual preventive maintenance service and repair services as requested on units specified in the Request for Proposal. Work includes but not limited to cleaning and inspecting heat chambers, electrical connections, control calibration, filter replacement, belts inspection/replacement, lubrication and fire and testing for maximum efficiency.

The basis of award will be determined using the criteria set forth in the Proposal Evaluation section of Request for Proposal.
