

Description of Creditable Services for DBEs

Regular Dealer – 60% Credit: Firm that owns, operates or maintains a store, warehouse or other establishment in which materials, supplies, equipment of the general character described by the project specifications are bought, kept in stock and regularly sold or leased to the public in the usual course of business. Sixty-per cent of the cost of materials or supplies will be applied toward the project goal.

Broker – amount of fees, commissions or mark-ups: A firm that does not store the product or use distribution equipment to distribute the product, but assists the Prime in securing the product described by the project specifications. The entire amount of fees, commissions or mark-ups charged for the procurement of the materials, supplies or equipment will be applied toward the project goal.

Trucking – 100% credit: Trucking of product with equipment owned and operated by the assigned trucking company. The trucking company must be responsible for the management and supervision of the entire trucking operation for which it is responsible on a particular contract.

Contractor/Subcontractor – 100% credit: Services provided the assigned company and performed by the companies own workforces with their own equipment. The company must be responsible for the management and supervision of the entire operation for which it is responsible on a particular contract.
