PROJECT BUDGET

The total Project cost is \$28,000,000 and includes \$25,000,000 for construction and \$3,000,000 for construction engineering. MaineDOT and the City of Portland are requesting \$22,400,000 in RCN funding. MaineDOT and the City of Portland will equally split the 20 percent total Project cost match of \$5,600,000, contributing \$2,800,000 equally. The Project is unable to be broken into components. MaineDOT and the City of Portland have provided funding commitment letters, and the funds are readily available. There are no additional funding sources committed to the Project.
