The City of Caribou is pleased to send you this letter in strong support of the Maine Department of Transportation's (MaineDOT) \$8 million application for the U.S. Department of Transportation's 2022-2023 Wildlife Crossings Pilot Program to help fund the Caribou Wildlife and Aquatic Habitat Crossing Grant project. MaineDOT is requesting these funds to address significant standing water issues after weather events and safety issues associated with large animal crossings.
