**JOB DESCRIPTION:** This is a technician position through the field inspection of bridges. The incumbent will be responsible for inspecting bridges in accordance with National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS) and collecting element level data, both of which is collected electronically using PONTIS bridge inspection software. The incumbent shall identify bridge deficiencies, take digital photos, compile and submit reports and identify needed repairs. The incumbent is responsible for developing schedules and strategies in order to deliver their annual inspection effort. The incumbent is responsible for maintaining PONTIS bridge inspection software and for creating queries to help maintenance efforts. Work is performed under limited supervision. Preference will be given to those who are NBIS certified.
