Have knowledge of safety rules, regulations, Departmental Policies and Procedures. Ability to supervise employees of lower classifications. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Have previous experience in the operation of the type of equipment. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age and must have a high school diploma or equivalent.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Have a valid Class A or B State of Maine license. Persons interested must live within reasonable travel distance of the Scarborough Maintenance Facility. Employees in this class must provide and wear safety boots while in work status. These boots must meet the ANSI standard and be at least six inches in height. Employees must be willing to work in higher classifications as an alternate, as he/she becomes qualified.

SELECTION PROCESS

Selection will be made in accordance with Administrative Bulletin #330, and on the basis of experience, past records, performance on an interview, and/or performance test on the operation of a wheeler type vehicle. Applications will be screened in order to select candidates for an interview.
