WHAT WILL BE COVERED

- * How to stay compliant with Bureau of Labor Standards
- * The latest 2003 minimum standards of the MUTCD
- * Your Town’s legal liability relative to Tort Claims and national, state, and local standards
- * Proper uses of cones, orange signs, barricades, flaggers, etc.
- * The parts of a typical work zone and how to deal with common problems.
- * How to warn the public when filling potholes, grading roads, replacing culverts, etc.
