


Traffic Alert

2015 Biddeford Projects

MaineDOT has a number of road projects in Biddeford during the 2015 construction season. To minimize inconvenience, we will be suspending road work during the La Kermesse Festival – June 25th -28th. All work is weather-dependent so dates may change.



- 1 Route 111** paving work will be done at night and alternating one-lane traffic will be maintained. The contractor is allowed 57 days to complete the project but it must be done by September 19, 2015.
- 2 Route 1** project began in June, 2014 and will resume this summer between Union and Gooch streets. In addition to our construction activity, the city has water and sewer projects between Main Street and South Street that are expected to be completed by June 1. MaineDOT projects will begin only when the city projects have been completed. There will be parking restrictions during construction and South Street and Alfred Street are recommended as alternate routes. All work, which will take place during the day, should be completed by mid-August.
- 3 West Street** work will begin in April and continue until June. This mill and fill project also includes repaving sidewalks and building a right-turn lane in front of Burger King. Alternating, one-lane traffic will be maintained during the daytime construction. However, motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- 4 Jefferson and Adams Streets** mill and fill projects, will take place August 15 - October 24. However, before MaineDOT begins its work, the city will be doing sewer pipe replacements in this vicinity.
- 5 Somesville Bridge** is being replaced so the current structure closes on April 20, 2015. The new bridge will open in late May 2016.
- 6 Elm St. Bridge** is undergoing rehabilitation starting August 2015, and will remain open through completion by July 1, 2016.
