


Traffic Alert

Route 1 in Thomaston



Route 1 in Thomaston is undergoing reconstruction beginning in late April of 2016 and continuing through November 2017. Crews will be allowed to work from 5 AM – 8 PM during the shoulder season. However during peak summer months, crews will be allowed to work until midnight. This \$ 8.4 million project will result in, not only a smoother, safer Route 1 but also:

- New sidewalks on both sides through the town;
- Sidewalk bump-outs to calm traffic;
- New storm drains;
- Slip lane at the intersection of Oyster River Road to minimize delays;
- “No right on red” traffic signals at the intersection of Beechwood and Knox to simplify the intersection to improve safety; and
- New parking configuration on Main Street to improve safety and mobility.
