BRIEF *SUMMARY: The proposed rule changes license fees for psychologists, psychological examiners, respiratory therapists, respiratory therapy technicians, dieticians, dietetic technicians, temporary dieticians, temporary dietetic technicians, speech-language pathologists, audiologists, combined speech-language pathologists and audiologists, temporary speech-language pathologists and audiologists and hearing aid dealers and fitters and trainee hearing aid dealers and fitters. The proposed rule reflects the replacement of the Oil and Solid Fuel Board and the Propane and Natural Gas Board by the new Maine Fuel Board, and creates a license fee for the new license category of limited wood pellet technician. The proposed rule standardizes the extended late renewal period for certified interior designers, and replaces the oral examination for psychologists with the Jurisprudence Examination.

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Notice of Agency Rule-making Proposal

DETAILED BASIS STATEMENT / SUMMARY: The proposed rule changes license fees as follows:

Psychologists and psychological examiners: Shortens the initial license term from 2 years to 1 year and reduces the license fee from \$400 every two years to \$200 annually. Replaces the oral examination for psychologists with the Jurisprudence Examination.

Respiratory therapists and respiratory therapy technicians: Shortens the initial license term from 2 years to 1 year and reduces the license fee from \$135 every two years to \$65 annually.

Dietetic licensees: Increases the license fee for dietitians and dietetic technicians from \$70 to \$150; increases the license fee for temporary dietitians and temporary dietetic technicians from \$50 to \$125.

Speech and hearing licensees: Increases the initial license fee for speech-language pathologists, audiologists, and combined speech-language pathologists and audiologists from \$90 to \$225; increases the renewal license fee for speech-language pathologists, audiologists and combined speech-language pathologists and audiologists from \$140 to \$225; increases the license fee for temporary speech language pathologists and audiologists from \$90 to \$225; reduces the license fee for hearing aid dealers and fitters from \$325 to \$110; and increases the license fee for trainee hearing aid dealer and fitters from \$100 to \$110.

Fuel Licensees: Effective January 1, 2010, the Maine Fuel Board replaces the Oil and Solid Fuel Board and the Propane and Natural Gas Board. (See PL 2009, c. 344.) This amendment repeals the fee provisions in this chapter for the Oil and Solid Fuel Board (former Section 5(26)) and the Propane and Natural Gas Board (former Section 5(31)). This amendment consolidates the fees formerly charged by these two boards into new Section 17-A, the Maine Fuel Board. The fees in Section 5(17-A) are carried forward without change. The only new fee is the license fee for the limited wood pellet technician. This license category was created by PL 2009, c. 344. The \$50 biennial fee is consistent with the license fee for other limited licenses.

Certified interior designers: Corrects the extended late renewal period from 91 days – 3 years after expiration to 91 days – 2 years after expiration.

Chapter 10: ESTABLISHMENT OF LICENSE FEES

Summary: This chapter establishes fees for professional and occupational licenses and registrations issued by the Office of Licensing and Registration.

1. Definitions

Unless the context otherwise indicates, the following words have the following meanings:

1. **3d party.** “3d party” refers to a fee for a standardized license examination that is paid directly by the applicant to the organization administering the examination or its designee.
2. **OLR.** “OLR” means the Office of Licensing and Registration.

2. Establishment of Fees; Effective Dates

OLR shall charge the license and other fees indicated in §§ 3 and 5 below. For initial licenses, and for applications and examinations, the fees set out below shall become effective upon the effective date of this chapter. For renewal licenses, the fees set out below shall become effective with the first renewal cycle occurring on or after the effective date of this chapter.

The license and other fees of OLR boards and regulatory functions not listed below are set by the statute and implementing rules governing the particular board or regulatory function.

3. Fees Applicable to All Boards and Regulatory Functions Listed in §4

Except as otherwise indicated, the fees listed in this section apply to all boards and regulatory functions listed in §5 below:

1. Replacement license..... \$10
2. Verification of licensure \$25
3. Photocopies.....No charge for first 7 pages, 25¢ for each page thereafter
4. Licensee register list on diskette or CD-ROM..... \$25

4. Refunds

If an applicant applies for a license listed in §5 for which a separate application fee is charged, the license fee will be refunded if the license is denied. All other fees listed in §§ 3 and 5 are nonrefundable.

5. Fees to be Charged For Particular Occupational and Professional Licenses and Registrations and Related Fees

The following fees shall be charged for the licenses, registrations, permits and other services listed in subsections 1–40 below. For any given license or registration, the designated fee shall apply to both initial issuance and renewal unless otherwise indicated. The term of a license or registration ends on the uniform expiration or renewal date established for that license or registration by law.

Fees are to be based upon the cross sectional area, which is the product of the maximum length of vessels and their maximum width or diameter:

- 3.1 Certificate inspection of each pressure vessel subject to inspection having a cross sectional area of 50 sq. ft. or less \$25.00
- 3.2 For each additional 100 sq. ft. of area in excess of 50 sq. ft..... \$25.00
- 3.3 The total cost of inspection for any one vessel will not exceed \$500.00. For example, a group of pressure vessels, such as the rolls of a paper machine or dryer operating as a single machine or unit, shall be considered as one pressure vessel.

Special trip or inspection by State employed inspectors will be based on \$50.00 per hour, at a minimum of 4 hours plus travel, lodging and meals.
