MINUTES – September 20, 2001

At 9:30 a.m., Rebecca Comeau, Acting Chair, called the meeting to order.

COMPLAINT #RT-006 AND REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY LICENSURE

Dennis Smith, Assistant Attorney General, presented Complaint #RT-006. This complaint involves a licensee who failed to indicate on an application for temporary licensure that she had been convicted “of a crime other than a minor traffic violation.” The Board subsequently issued this individual a temporary license and through a report received from the State Bureau of Identification, learned of this individual’s conviction. After being issued her temporary license, this individual also took and subsequently failed the radiography examination taken through the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists and has requested a second temporary license.

In a motion by Russell Briggs, seconded by Rebecca Comeau, the Board voted unanimously to offer this individual a Consent Agreement in which she admits to having failed to disclose her conviction and agrees to pay a fine of \$100.00. Upon the licensee’s acceptance of the Consent Agreement and payment of the \$100.00 fine, the Board agrees to issue this individual a second temporary license as a Radiologic technologist.

LIMITED LICENSE TRAINEE STATUS

Amy L. Daniel – A request for the Limited License Trainee status for Amy L. Daniel in the area of podiatry was reviewed and unanimously approved in a motion by Russell Briggs and seconded by William Curtis. Ms. Daniel will be training at Associated Foot Care in Lewiston under the supervision of Drs. Joseph Greco and Amy Wells.
