APPROVAL OF MINUTES

LIMITED LICENSE TRAINEE STATUS

Jinnie Perkins – Ms. Perkins, whose status as a Limited License Trainee will expire on January 18, 2002, has submitted a request for an extension. She is currently training at the Peninsula Primary Care in Blue Hill under the supervision of Dr. Marjorie Olivari and Dr. Benjamin Bamford in Category III and IV (Chest and Extremities). Terry Zipper moved to grant a one year extension. Seconded by Brian Brock. Vote: Favor-7 Opposed-0 Abstained-1

Dianna Paine – A request for the Limited License Trainee status for Category III and IV (Chest and Extremities) was reviewed. Ms. Paine would like to train at Peninsula Primary Care in Castine under the supervision of Dr. Marjorie Olivari and Dr. Benjamin Bamford. Brian Brock moved to approve. Seconded by Terry Zipper. Vote: Favor-7 Opposed-0 Abstained-1

CORRESPONDENCE – CHERYLE P. MANNING

The Board reviewed and discussed the December 17, 2001 correspondence from Cheryle Manning an individual who requested reciprocity of her limited license. Upon receiving Ms. Manning's application in November 2001, a letter was written informing her that in order to receive a limited license, Maine rules require a twelve month training period and upon completion of this training, an individual must sit for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Limited Scope State Licensing Examination. Ms. Manning was also informed that since she held this type of license in the State of Wyoming, her training period would be waived and she would only need to sit for the examination.

Ms. Manning is writing to the Board questioning the fact that it is necessary for her to retake the ARRT Limited Scope State Licensing Examination since Board Rules Chapter 1 §8 allows for reciprocity.

Brian Brock moved that the Board write a letter to Ms. Manning clarifying the rules relating to limited licensure. Seconded by Terry Zipper. Vote: Favor-8 Opposed-0

Ms Manning will be informed that the Limited Scope State Licensing Examination is provided and graded by the ARRT for the State of Maine, but is not National Certification. It is only a means to obtain a license to practice. Chapter 1 § 8 of Board Rules which explains reciprocity refers to Nationally Certified Technologists who have graduated from an accredited school of radiologic technology, have passed the national registry given by the ARRT and received the title of Registered Technologist. It does not cover State Limited Licensed Technologists. The Board waives the training period for individuals who have held limited licenses in other states due to their prior training and experience, however, since curriculum and training vary among states, the Board still requires that an examination be taken to test an individuals training and experience level.
