CALL TO ORDER

Dawn Commune, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

In a motion by William Curtis, seconded by Carrie Owen, the board voted unanimously to approve the August 25, 2005 minutes as written.

COMPLAINT PRESENTATIONS

Judith Peters, Assistant Attorney General, presented the following complaints to the board:

RT-011 – After a thorough discussion of the circumstances of the complaint, the board determined that there was sufficient evidence that the licensee did not answer truthfully the application question regarding her criminal history to pursue the disciplinary process. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. § 9860, “the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license” is subject to discipline by the board.

In a motion by William Curtis, seconded by Ann Hall, the board voted unanimously to offer this licensee a Consent Agreement. The proposed terms of the Consent Agreement are an admission to failing to disclose criminal convictions on the application and acceptance of a formal reprimand and payment of a fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) as sanction for the above violation.

RT-008 – In a motion by Elizabeth Quate, seconded by Carrie Owen, the board voted unanimously to table this complaint for further information to determine if the board should offer a consent agreement or schedule an adjudicatory hearing.

ELECTION OF COMPLAINT OFFICER

In a motion by Elizabeth Quate, seconded by Carrie Owen, the board voted unanimously to elect Ann Hall as Complaint Officer.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT – PENNY VAILLANCOURT

Ms. Vaillancourt provided an update of the board's financial status and of the number of active licensees.

The board was provided with current copies of statutes and rules pertaining to licensure.

A committee was set up to review the board's current rules. Dawn Commune and Elizabeth Quate volunteered to be on this committee.
