**CALL TO ORDER**

Dawn Commune, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**ADJUDICATORY HEARING – COMPLAINT #RT-008**

The board met in public session for the purpose of convening an adjudicatory hearing to determine whether grounds exist for the board to take disciplinary action against the radiologic technology license of Michael Frazier. Judith Peters, Assistant Attorney General, presented the State's case and James E. Smith, Esq. served as Presiding Officer.

At the conclusion of the hearing, a motion was made by Dawn Commune, seconded by William Curtis, that this licensee should be reprimanded for violation of 32 M.R.S.A. Sec. 9860.6. "Unprofessional conduct." The board voted 7-0 in favor of the motion.

In a motion by Brian Brock, seconded by Ann Hall, the board voted unanimously that Mr. Frazier shall pay a fine of \$3,000.00 (\$1,500 per each violation) and that he shall pay any costs related to the hearing.

**ADJUDICATORY HEARING – COMPLAINT #RT-011**

This hearing has been continued for another six months.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

In a motion by William Curtis, seconded by Brian Brock, the board voted unanimously to approve the January 19, 2006 minutes as written.

## **APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS**

April D. Morgan – In a motion by Elizabeth Quate, seconded by Brian Brock, the board voted unanimously to grant Ms. Morgan’s request for a second Temporary Radiologic Technologist’s license for Nuclear Medicine.

Flint Ansdén – In a motion by Brian Brock, seconded by Carrie Owen, the board voted unanimously to grant Mr. Ansdén’s request for a Radiologic Technology license for Radiography and to also send a letter to this licensee informing him of the Board’s concerns regarding the criminal convictions that he failed to disclose on his application for licensure and to remind him that he is required to disclose all criminal convictions on any application for licensure that asks the criminal conviction question.

## **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

In a motion by Brian Brock, seconded by William Curtis, the board voted unanimously to re-elect Dawn Commune as Chairperson, Carrie Owen as Vice Chair and Ann Hall as Complaint Officer

## **CHAIR’S REPORT – DAWN COMMUNE**

## **ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT – PENNY VAILLANCOURT**

Ms. Vaillancourt reported that LD 1770, “An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Licensure of Workers in the Field of Radiologic Technology” is somewhere between the House and Senate. Once this law has been approved, the Rules Committee will start meeting on a regular basis for a review of the rules.

In a motion by Brian Brock, seconded by Carrie Owen, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn at 11:30 a.m.
