December 16, 2002 Board Meeting

CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Cheryl Walters established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

BUSINESS:

A. Action on November minutes.

Norleen Fleming moved to approve the minutes as written. It was seconded by Judy Flaker.

Vote:4-in favor; 0-opposed

B. Action to be taken on License Applications:

There were 10 license applications: Six were approved, two were pended and two were denied. A motion was made by Judy Flaker to accept the applications, as reviewed. It was seconded by Nancy Steeves.

Vote: 4-in favor; 0-opposed.

C. Action taken on BESPAs activity number applications:

Eight activities were approved. A motion was made by Nancy Steeves to approve applications as reviewed. It was seconded by Judy Flaker.

Vote:4-in favor; 0-opposed.

D. Correspondence:

No correspondence was pending.

E. Miscellaneous:

Deborah Kallen license application. Deb Kallen was present to speak to the Board. After a long discussion, the Board decided to deny her request for a license at this time. Although she has an extensive background, she has not met the qualifications established in the Board Rules. The Board outlined the following two options for her: 1)

She can reapply for a temporary license with a new supervisory plan; or 2) she can apply for permanent licensure under Option 2 by completing 19 more CEUs and 2160 work hours or take and pass the Praxis Exam and apply under Option 1. When she re-applies and is granted a license, unlicensed practice (2 hours) will be discussed. A motion was made by Norleen Fleming to deny the license and present her with the options discussed above. It was seconded by Nancy Steeves.
Vote: 4-in favor 0-opposed
