	2/24/09	WCB-1, Employer's First Report of Occupational Injury or Disease


2. That the forms listed above were filed late.
3. That the failure to file the foregoing forms timely represents two (2) separate violations of 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B).

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B), Crum & Forster shall pay a civil forfeiture of \$100.00 for the foregoing two (2) violations for a total penalty of \$200.00, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine. 
