CONSENT DECREE**

**NOW COME** the parties and agree as follows:


1. That Chris Zeigler alleged a June 28, 2006 work-related injury while employed at Carlen Transport, Inc.
2. That Chris Zeigler gave notice of incapacity from work for his alleged injury on July 3, 2006.
3. That Chris Zeigler was compensated and received subsequent compensation for his alleged period of incapacity.
4. That the subsequent payment to Chris Zeigler, dated December 4, 2006, was made sixty-seven (67) days after the previous indemnity payment, dated September 28, 2006.
5. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
6. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of Chris Zeigler's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that he is or may be entitled to.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Maine Motor Transport Association Workers' Compensation shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to Chris Zeigler. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta, ME 04333.



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

CONSENT DECREE

NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:


1. That Jeffrey Dolloff alleged a March 22, 2006 work-related injury while employed at Richard Carrier Trucking.
2. That Jeffrey Dolloff gave notice of incapacity from work for his alleged injury on March 30, 2006.
3. That Jeffrey Dolloff was compensated for his alleged period of incapacity.
4. That Jeffrey Dolloff was totally incapacitated on March 25, 2006. Payment for that incapacity was made August 1, 2007, which was four hundred seventy-three (473) days after compensation became due and payable (April 15, 2006).
5. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
6. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of Jeffrey Dolloff's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that he is or may be entitled to.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Maine Motor Transport Association Workers' Compensation shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to Jeffrey Dolloff. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333.



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
1. That Chris Zeigler alleged a June 28, 2006 work-related injury while employed at Carlen Transport, Inc.
2. That Chris Zeigler gave notice of incapacity from work for his alleged injury on July 3, 2006.
3. That Chris Zeigler was compensated for his alleged period of incapacity.
4. That Chris Zeigler was totally incapacitated on July 1, 2006 and July 2, 2006. Payment for that incapacity has not yet been made. *(paid 9/13/07 - see attached)*
5. That Chris Zeigler is due indemnity in the amount of \$150.15. *(Already paid - see attached)*
6. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
7. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of Chris Zeigler's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that he is or may be entitled to.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Maine Motor Transport Association Workers' Compensation shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to Chris Zeigler. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333. Proof of payment for the outstanding indemnity (\$150.15) shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333.


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NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:

1. That the following forms are required pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. and/or Board-approved Rules:

Roy, Roger A.	10/22/06	WCB-2A, Schedule of Dependent(s) and Filing Status Statement

2. That the forms listed above were filed late.


3. That the failure to file the foregoing forms timely represents two (2) separate violations of 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B).

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B), Maine Motor Transport Association Workers' Compensation shall pay a civil forfeiture of \$100.00 for the late filed WCB-1 and \$50.00 for the late filed WCB-2A for a total penalty of \$150.00, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine. The penalty payment shall be sent to the to the attention of Mr. Steven Minkowsky, Deputy Director of Benefits Administration, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0027.


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
