

CONSENT DECREE**

NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:


1. That John Wingfield alleged a November 7, 2007 work-related injury while employed at Lee Dodge – Hyundai.
2. That John Wingfield gave notice of incapacity from work for his alleged injury on November 10, 2007.
3. That John Wingfield was compensated and received subsequent compensation for his alleged period of incapacity.
4. That payment for November 10, 2007, November 11, 2007 and the seven-day waiting period was made March 26, 2008, which was one hundred twenty-one (121) days after compensation became due and payable (November 26, 2007).
5. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
6. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of John Wingfield's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that he is or may be entitled to.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Maine Automobile Dealers Association Workers' Compensation Trust shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to John Wingfield. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333.



NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:


1. That the following form is required pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. and/or Board-approved Rules:



WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B), Maine Automobile Dealers Association Workers' Compensation Trust shall pay a civil forfeiture of \$100.00 for each of the foregoing twelve (12) violations for a total penalty of \$1,200.00, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine.
