CONSENT DECREE


NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:

1. That Debra Clough alleged an October 31, 2007 work-related injury while employed at Hartwell House.
2. That Debra Clough gave notice of incapacity from work for her alleged injury on November 1, 2007.
3. That Debra Clough was compensated and received subsequent compensation for her alleged period of incapacity.
4. That the claimant was totally incapacitated on January 17, 2008. Payment for that incapacity was made December 4, 2008, which was three hundred eight (308) days after compensation became due and payable (January 31, 2008).
5. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
6. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of Debra Clough's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that she is or may be entitled to.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Patriot Insurance Company shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to Debra Clough. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333.



CONSENT DECREE


NOW COME the parties and agree as follows:

1. That Ralph Place alleged a December 5, 2007 work-related injury while employed at Save On Fuel.
2. That Ralph Place gave notice of incapacity from work for his alleged injury on December 10, 2007.
3. That Ralph Place was compensated and received subsequent compensation for his alleged period of incapacity.
4. That wages earned by the claimant from another employer were improperly offset to pay this claim. Payment of accrued benefits was made December 4, 2008, which was one hundred fifty-one (151), one hundred forty-four (144) and sixty (60) after compensation became due and payable (July 6, 2008, July 13, 2008, and October 5, 2008, respectively).
5. That pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3) a penalty of \$1,500.00 is warranted.
6. That nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver of Ralph Place's right to seek any benefits and/or additional penalties that he is or may be entitled to.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §205(3), Patriot Insurance Company shall pay a penalty of \$1,500.00 payable to Ralph Place. This penalty check shall state that, "This penalty payment is made pursuant to a Maine Workers' Compensation Board Audit". A copy of the penalty payment shall be sent to the attention of the Audit Division, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta ME 04333.




